Intervention Area Democracy & Governance



Main challenges:

- War ongoing on European territory
- “long democratic recession”
- Growing number of countries moving towards authoritarianism
- Multilateral global governance is under historic stress



Intervention Area Democracy & Governance

The proposed research aims to contribute to the protection and nurturing of democracies, with a WP that is both “**reactive**” and “**proactive**”.



→ On the “**reactive**” side, we want to facilitate **evidence-based responses** to protect democracies.

→ On the “**proactive**” side, we are looking into how to make democracies **more resilient from within**.

Expected impact:

Democratic governance is reinvigorated by improving the **accountability, transparency, effectiveness** and **trustworthiness** of **rule-of-law** based institutions and policies and through the expansion of active and inclusive **citizenship** empowered by the safeguarding of **fundamental rights**.

Participation of Joint Research Center (JRC)

The Joint Research Centre is the **Commission's science and knowledge service**.

The JRC employs scientists to carry out research in order to provide independent scientific advice and support to EU policy.

AT PROPOSAL STAGE

- Under Horizon Europe, the JRC **can** participate in proposals as a beneficiary (with no funding).
- Applicants *can* include the JRC, but **not compulsory** and will not impact evaluation scores negatively if don't.
- **If want to work with the JRC: participation of the JRC must be included in proposal.**
- Any communication between the JRC and the applicants **will be made available by the JRC to all other applicants** in order to ensure equal treatment and opportunities.
- If the applicants do not include the JRC in their proposal, the JRC **will not** join the consortium.

IF SELECTED

- If a proposal wanting the work with the JRC is selected, discussions will start **after** the evaluation to agree on the details.
- **Only if the two parties find an agreement** will the JRC be part of the consortium and accede to the grant agreement.
- Should an agreement not be found between the JRC and the selected consortium, this should not per se negatively affect the project, **provided that all call/topic conditions are met by the consortium even without the participation of the JRC.**

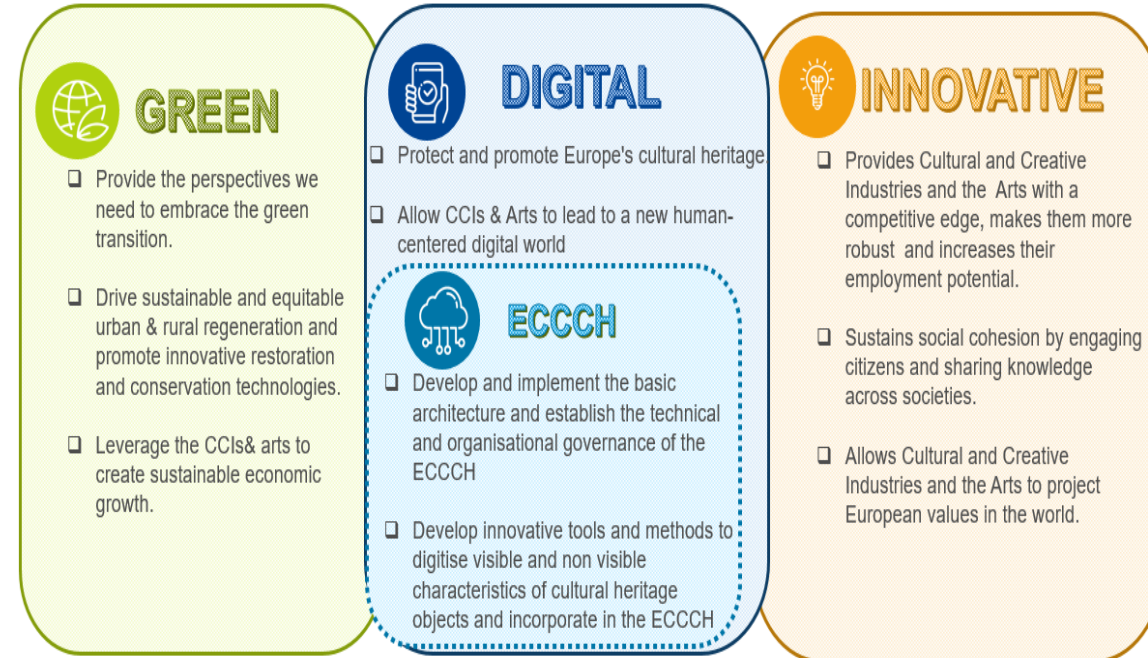


European Cultural Heritage And The Cultural & Creative Industries Intervention Area



Main challenges:

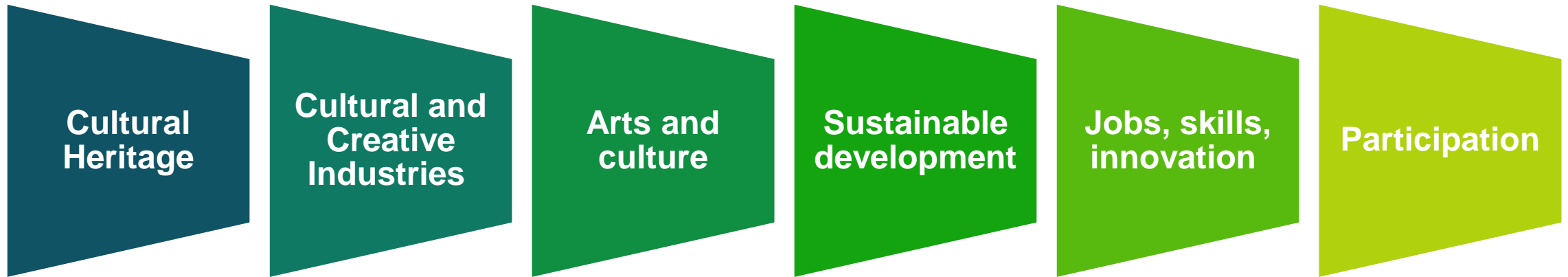
- Europe's cultural heritage and its cultural and creative industries need to mobilize their resources to support societies for an inclusive, socially and culturally sustainable climate transition

A European Collaborative Cloud for Cultural Heritage



Main challenges:

- Identify and develop **new technologies**, such as cloud services, including a **European cultural heritage collaborative space** for museums and other cultural institutions, to increase accessibility.



ECCCH

- Develop and implement the basic architecture and establish the technical and organisational governance of the ECCCH
- Develop innovative tools and methods to digitise visible and non visible characteristics of cultural heritage objects and incorporate in the ECCCH

A European Collaborative Cloud for Cultural Heritage



is responding to evolving needs...



- **Data sharing and exchange** – will empower small and big museums through co-creation and tools adapted to their specific needs
- **Collaboration and interaction** – connect researchers, academics, CCIs and other professional stakeholders, enable interaction and collaboration
- Establish a **secure and independent European platform**, including specifically designed IPR management and traceability
- Stimulate European **cultural heritage research**, increase knowledge and know-how
- Extended data and meta data storage, including **long-term sustainability of data and data formats**
- A place where **European museums and CH institutions** - big and small - **work together**

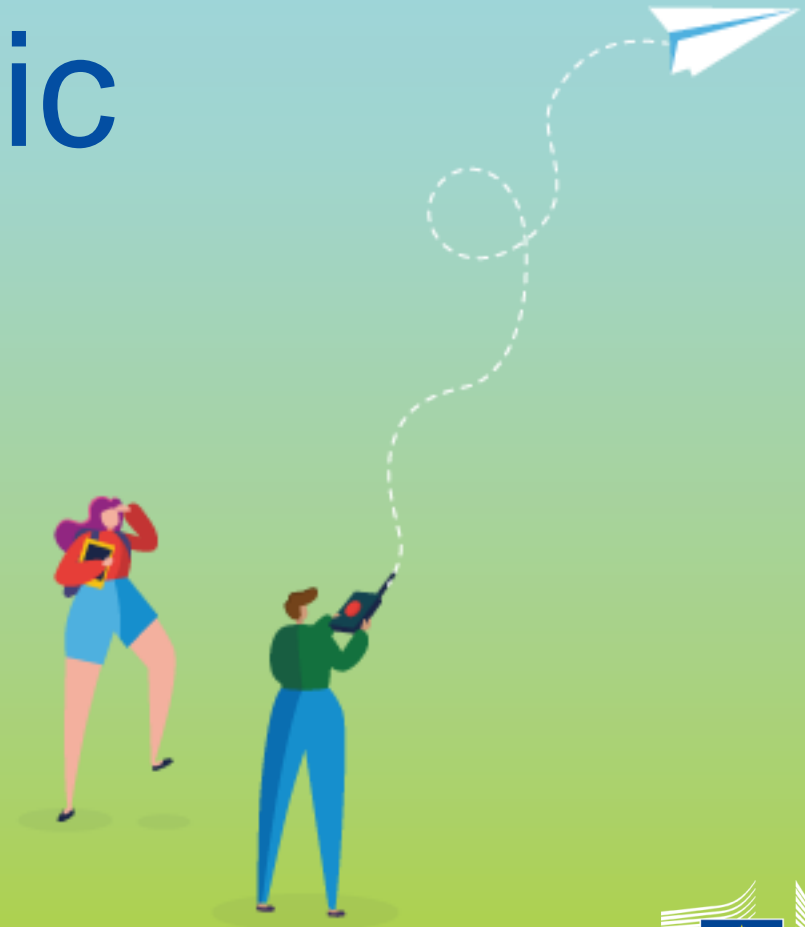

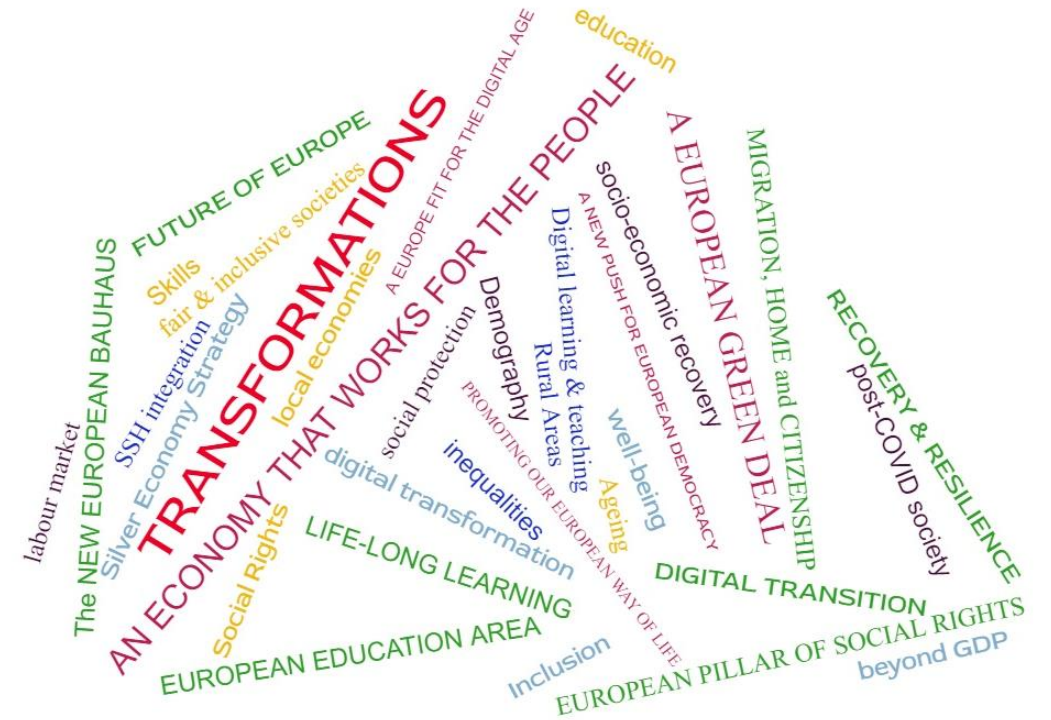


Intervention Area Social and Economic Transformations

- Make the most out of the green and digital transitions, while leaving no one behind
- Tackle inequalities, including gender inequalities



Intervention Area Social and Economic Transformations



The proposed research aims to strengthen the EU's inclusive growth and upward convergence

Expected impacts:

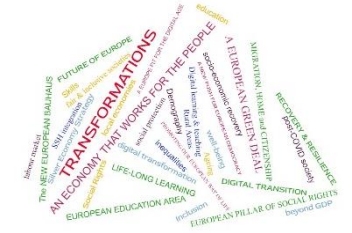
- **Social and economic resilience and sustainability are strengthened** through a better understanding of the social, ethical, political and economic impacts of drivers of change (such as **technology, globalisation, demographics, mobility and migration**) and their interplay.
- **Inclusive growth is boosted** and vulnerabilities are reduced effectively through evidence-based policies for **protecting and enhancing employment, education, social fairness and tackling inequalities**, including in response to the socio-economic challenges due to the COVID-19 pandemic and economic consequences of Russian aggression of Ukraine.

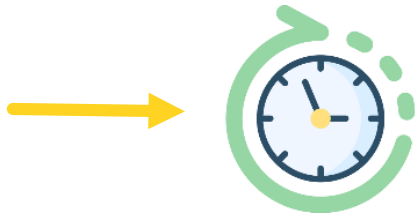

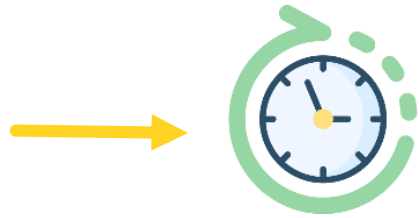

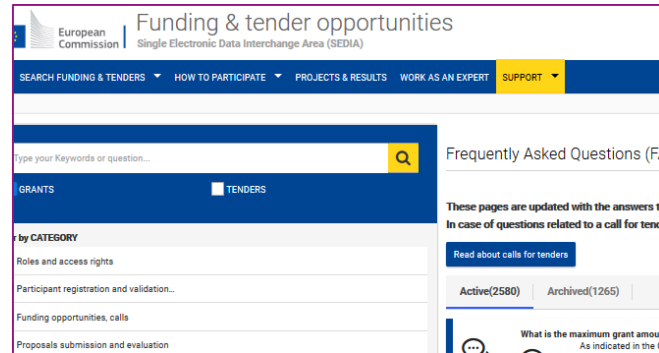
