



- ✓ **SWORD** (EIT Health, Portugal): virtual care for patients with musculoskeletal (MSK) pain.







Participating organisations per KIC and AREA (2014-2021)







Planned EIT Funding 2021-2022 (thousands, EUR)





TF KnowNet

Supported by EIT Manufacturing

TF KnowNet delivers a program where students, researchers and companies can work together to develop skills and share expert knowledge.

They do so through the co-creation of solutions to industrial manufacturing challenges, extending the established Teaching Factory (TF) paradigm to the network level.

With the support of EIT Manufacturing, the consortium, led by the Greek Laboratory for Manufacturing Systems and Automation, was able to identify academic and industrial needs and design the methodology, framework and functions of the knowledge exchange network. The 3 pilot activities brought together 7 organizations and almost 100 individuals

- Academic partners (Aalto University, Mondragon University, Polytechnic University Milan, TU Braunschweig and University of Patras) and three Industrial partners (Volkswagen, Volvo, and PRIMA)



Maritime ClimAccelerator

Supported by EIT Climate-KIC

The Maritime ClimAccelerator is a consortium initiative led by the EIT Climate-KIC Cyprus Hub, involving a network of partners from Cyprus, Greece, Spain and the Netherlands. Resulted from a Europe-wide competition, the initiative will offer funding, training, peer to peer coaching and theme-specific mentoring to start-ups, positioning Cyprus in the global innovation landscape for maritime and shipping value chains.

The objective is thus to provide yearly 30-40 start-ups with the opportunity to develop, test and validate innovative solutions for the sustainable transition of the maritime industry, both locally and globally, and therefore to ultimately pitch their ideas in front of investors, port authorities and shipping companies.

- The project budget is €1,050,000, including a 50% co-funding by EIT Climate-KIC
- 26 start-ups are already benefitting from the programme, with more to be added soon



EIT HEI INITIATIVE INNOVATION CAPACITY BUILDING FOR HIGHER EDUCATION

Objective:

- Create systemic impact by engaging HEIs at institutional level
 - Strengthen the entrepreneurial and innovation capacity of HEIs at institutional level
 - Strengthen integration into innovation ecosystems

First pilot Call Results:

- 32 countries, 24 projects x 1.2 Million (2021-2023)

4 CY beneficiaries in 3 projects (3 HEIs)
22 GR beneficiaries in 6 projects (7 HEIs)

Next steps:

- Ongoing assessment of 2nd Call -> 40 projects x 1.2 Million max per project (2 years)
- New calls coming as of Fall 2022/ early 2023

EIC & EIT COOPERATION

2021 Results:

- ✓ FastTrack mechanism to the EIC Accelerator in place for all KICs
- ✓ Pilot cooperation (CSA) with four KICs ongoing – 1 Mio Euro each for 1 year

2022 Focus:

- “Seamless” access to relevant **advisory services** for all EIC and EIT supported startups
- Supporting **female entrepreneurs**, opening the EIC Women Leadership Programme to women-led deep-tech startups from EIT
- Using the experience of the ongoing pilot actions (funded by EIC and implemented by four KICs) to create a sustainable basis for collaboration involving all KICs
- Joint **communication materials** (guidance for startups etc) and joint **communication events**
- Simplify access to **EIC Fasttrack, Data exchange** on common beneficiaries, **synergies with EEN** in EU-13/ EIT RIS countries, **Innovation projects** (from Pathfinder to KIC support), involve **KIC investors & funding initiatives** to EIC invest scheme, **EIT Alumni internships** in EIC supported startups

FASTTRACK to EIC ACCELERATOR

THE OPPORTUNITY

- ✓ Approx. 30% of EIC Accelerator successful companies in 2021 have been supported by EIT KICs - 20 out of 65 in the June cut-off & 29 out of 99 in the October cut-off
- ✓ EIC support can help scale up EIT Community innovations



FASTTRACK to EIC ACCELERATOR

OUR ACTION

- **Fastrack** for EIT supported startups / scaleups **in place** since 25 Oct 2021
- KICs **supporting the application** of a number of EIT **Community - supported startups / scaleups** for the March cut-off date, **within the quota for 2022** for the EIT Community (100+)
- EIC Accelerator 2022 cut-off dates (March, Jun, Oct) -> Check EIC website
- Calls to EIT-supported startups / scaleups -> Check EIT KICs websites / social media channels for calls to the EIT-EIC Fastrack.
